Alfalfa is commonly fed to pregnant mares and active horses. It is rich in protein, and thus needs to be fed to horses in a small quantity, along with adequate feed and fresh, clean drinking water.

Alfalfa Dairy Hay: Large Bales

This can be fed to both horses and cattle. Bales average 1,000-1,100 lbs. each.

- Protein: 17-19%
- Relative Feed Value: Range 150-165
